



Sponsorship & Giveaway Policy

Vodafone New Zealand Foundation Policy 2.6

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The Vodafone New Zealand Foundation has strong relationships with many community organisations around Aotearoa New Zealand. We value these relationships and we endeavour to support our community partners to our best ability. We receive ad hoc requests to provide hardware, event sponsorship and event tickets on a regular basis. We are unable to meet all of these requests. This policy outlines the constraints that exist around such giveaways and the circumstances and manner in which these things may be offered.

Hardware and event tickets

As a general rule, the Vodafone Foundation does not provide our community partners with hardware or tickets to Vodafone sponsored events. Occasionally and unpredictably, the Vodafone New Zealand Foundation receives devices from Vodafone, or tickets to Vodafone sponsored events (such as the RNZB and Warriors games). When this occurs, the Vodafone Foundation staff team will offer these tickets and devices to community partners based on geographic location, perceived needs and expressions of interest.

Community partners are encouraged to register their needs and interest with the Foundation staff in anticipation of such devices and tickets becoming available.

Sponsorship

The Vodafone New Zealand Foundation does not sponsor fundraising events and activities for our community partners.

The Vodafone New Zealand Foundation team may connect community partners with to the Vodafone New Zealand sponsorship team at their discretion and based communication with the sponsorship team.

Exceptional Circumstances

The Vodafone New Zealand Foundation may choose to work alongside Vodafone New Zealand to provide devices or connectivity to organisations and/or sectors of society when it aligns with our strategic intent, is an integral part of creating positive change and does not contravene our charitable constraints.

This policy is designed to be applied when the nature of the requests are opportunistic, for fundraising purposes and/or not related to the specific outcomes of a programme or project.
